Permission to apply over the counter topicals and sprays on external areas only. These include bug spray, sunscreen, lip balm, vaseline, lotion, cream, ointment, etc. These must have been previously applied by the parent to show no adverse effects to the child (i.e. rash, irritation, or other reaction). **Prescription topicals and spays require the Medication Administration Authorization Form 1216.**
